## CONTACT ZONIES RULES:

1. All participants and instructors must bring masks and be prepared to wear them, when required by the teacher, during set up and tear down and course walks. Handlers will not be required to wear masks during exercises and runs. Everyone will be asked to practice social distancing.
2. All class participants must be current members of Contact Zonies. Memberships run from September 1- August 31st.
3. Participant attests that the rabies vaccination/titer date provided is accurate and current in accordance with Maricopa County Animal Care and Control.
4. Participants are expected to assist in the set-up and/or tear down of equipment for class. Let your instructor know if you have mobility or lifting restrictions. Class time is 75 minutes and includes 15 minutes for setup and/or tear down of equipment.
5. Classes are taught by volunteer club members and are not paid professional instructors; all instructors are qualified to teach their class level.
6. Class lessons follow a written curriculum that is carefully designed to provide a safe, cohesive, consistent, and progressive approach to training all of the agility obstacles and handling maneuvers.
7. Contact Zonies' training philosophy is based on a positive reinforcement methodology. No force or coercion is used in our training approach. Food, toy play and praise are the primary reinforcers employed to creating a positive learning environment for both the dog and handler.
8. Participants are not allowed to use e-collars at any time while on the training field. Prong collars and gentle leaders are allowed but must be removed when the dog is doing an exercise.
9. Participants must be able to recall their dogs in a safe and timely manner.

### **Refunds:**

- A 100% refund, less a \$15 cancellation fee, is available for cancellations submitted BEFORE the first day of class.
- The cancellation fee will be waived with proof from a veterinarian that the dog is injured and unable to participate.
- Students and/or dogs unable to continue after the 1st or 2nd week of class are eligible for a voucher for a future session (of the same class). The voucher's expiration date will be two (2) years from the session start date of the dropped class. No refunds or vouchers are given after the 2nd week of class.
